SUMMARY: Grace and Peace is a new church plant starting in September. Grace and Peace will be located in Northeast Denver in one of Denver's oldest neighborhoods. Grace and Peace is founded by Rev. Matt Morginsky. Matt has been in full time pastoral ministry for over 5 years, ordained through the Presbyterian Church of America, and a graduate of Covenant Theological Seminary. Prior to Seminary and becoming an ordained minister, Matt was the founder of the band OC Supertones which toured extensively and recorded 10 albums – including reaching No. 2 on Billboard's Top Christian Albums.

Matt has extensive experience building and leading music teams, so less experience in this area is not a prohibiting factor. This is an excellent opportunity to develop leadership skills in those areas for a gifted musician.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Gifted by the Holy Spirit for leading God's people into worship through music
- Vocal and instrumental proficiency on either piano or guitar (piano preferred)
- Enough understanding of music fundamentals to lead volunteer musicians
- Willingness to learn new styles of worship music in order to adapt to the unique mission field of Northeast Denver
- Humble attitude and sufficient maturity in Christ to be entrusted with a key leadership position

• Plan and execute the music portion of Sunday worship service

including attendance at a small group

• The worship leader will work an average of 8 hrs per week; 4 Sunday morning, 4 planning and

rehearsing

• The worship leader will actively expand the worship music repertoire of Grace and Peace by 4

new songs per quarter

DEFINITION OF THE MINISTRY RESIDENCY PROGRAM:

By Definition the Residency Program is an Internship and contains the following:

- Similar ministry training as that available in and through schooling for future clergy;
 This training is for the benefit of the trainee;
- 3. Resident is not a replacement for a regular employee, but works under close observation;
 - 4. This program is considered to be of greater value to the trainee than to the employer;
 - 5. Trainees are not necessarily entitled to a job at the completion of the program;
- 6. Employer and trainee understand that trainees are not entitled to wages for the time spent in training.
