RESPONSIBILITIES AND OPPORTUNITIES:

Role: Ministry development in two areas: 1) Connect resources and training offered by the ministry of *Christlike Dialogue* (CD) with leaders or influencers of churches, parachurch ministries, or other organizations to schedule training events, other speaking engagements, or small group studies by developing and maintaining social media awareness of CD and other creative ways of building relationships. 2) Increase the contributions from individuals and groups which may include grant writing, fundraising events, and other relationship building activities.

During the course of the internship, the intern may have the opportunity to experience Christlike Dialogue's training, and apply these principles in small group discussions. This training can be of significant value in preparing an intern to learn how to engage people with opposing

views in conversations that glorify God. The intern will also have opportunities to learn from Christian nonprofit fundraisers.

DEFINITION OF THE MINISTRY RESIDENCY PROGRAM:

By Definition the Residency Program is an Internship and contains the following:

- 1. Similar ministry training as that available in and through schooling for future clergy;
 - 2. This training is for the benefit of the trainee;
- 3. Resident is not a replacement for a regular employee, but works under close observation;
 - 4. This program is considered to be of greater value to the trainee than to the employer;
 - 5. Trainees are not necessarily entitled to a job at the completion of the program;
- 6. Employer and trainee understand that trainees are not entitled to wages for the time spent in training.
