

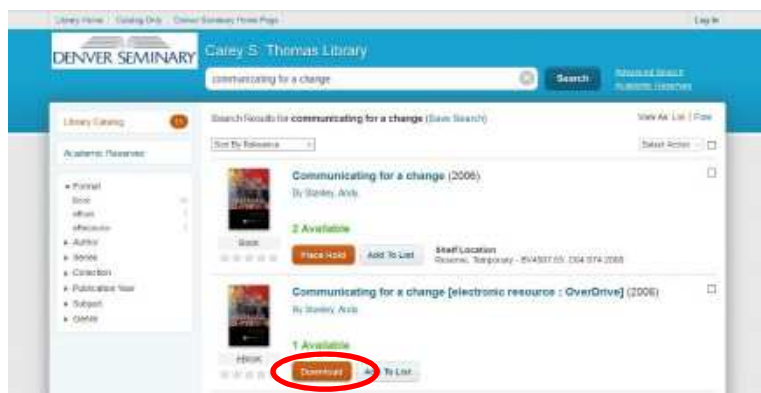
## Denver Seminary User Guide

### What You Will Need

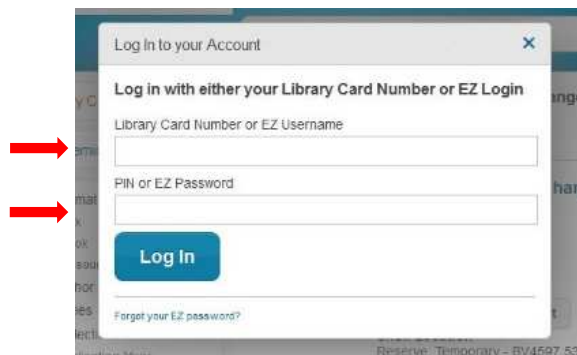
- A computer
- Access to the Carey S. Thomas Library's LS2 PAC (Public Access Catalog)
- Access to the OverDrive application
- *Additional resources may be required depending on the format and medium of the downloaded book (listed below)*

### The Steps

1. OverDrive eBooks can be found on the Carey S. Thomas Library's LS2 PAC. OverDrive eBooks will be listed as "electronic resource: OverDrive." For information on EBSCO eBooks, please see the applicable handout. Once you have located an OverDrive eBook that you would like to download, click on "Download," circled below.





2. Once you click on that link, you will be directed to the following prompt. You will need to enter your 14-digit Library Card Number (found on the back of your Student ID) or EZ Username, along with your PIN or EZ Password. If you can't remember your credentials, please contact the Circulation Desk for assistance.

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3. Search the Denver Seminary database for the book you want to borrow. Once you find it, click "borrow."
4. The app will typically give you the option of downloading the book directly to the app, or downloading it to your separate Kindle app (download required).
5. Books will automatically expire and be returned in 7 days.
