

Remote Access to Denver Seminary Library Electronic Resources

Denver Seminary Students, Faculty and Staff have access to Library electronic resources from off campus. The electronic resources include online databases, online journals/articles, eBooks* & videos.

After clicking on an available database from the Database page, an online journal from the Library catalog, a journal article posted in Moodle, and EBSCO eBook or a streaming video from the Psychotherapy.net list, you will be presented with the following screen to authenticate your access to the content:
